



2026 Jefferson County Shooting Sports State Qualifier: BB Gun and Air Rifle

Jefferson County Shooting Sports will be hosting a shooting sports match for BB Gun and Air Rifle. This match is a state qualifier. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4H age 8-15 for BB and 9-18 for air rifle. We will have a fun shoot for the 8-year-olds.

NOTE: The minimum age to participate in the state match for BB Gun and Air Rifle is 4-H age 9.

Registration forms are due by Saturday, January 31, 2026. Late registrations will only be accepted to fill relays. Registration fees are \$15/discipline. Registration will begin at 8:00am- **each county needs to verify each shooter's information when checking in for correct age and discipline being shot.** The match will begin at 9:00am. State qualifying rules will be observed in each discipline. Check the 4-H shooting sports website for state qualifying rules. There will be awards given to the top 3 in each position and aggregate for both new shooters and returning shooters in the 9-10, 11-13, 14-15 age groups in BB Gun and 14 and under, 15 and over for Air Rifle. Team awards will also be awarded to the top 3 teams, as determined by aggregate scores. Team members will be selected by Orion. **Fees will be collected at onsite registration.** There will be a concession stand hosted by the shooting sports families.

BB Gun: Shooters will shoot 10 shots in each of the 4 positions. Rules will follow the current Kansas State Match Program Rules (NRA BB Gun rulebook with some modifications), NRA 5-Meter BB Gun Rulebook, & Daisy National BB Gun Rules. Targets will be changed after each position. To qualify for the State Match, the minimum individual score is 335 out of 400 possible.

Air Rifle: Shooters will shoot the following course of fire: Orion Air Rifle targets: Shoot 3x20 course of fire at 10m to include 20 shots in each position: Kneeling, Prone, & Standing. Targets will be changed after each position. Air Rifle will follow the current Kansas State Match Rules & 2024-2026 National Standard Three-position Air Rifle Rules. To qualify for the State Match, the minimum individual score is 450 out of 600 possible.
