Air Rifle and Air Pistol Qualifier

Leavenworth County and Wyandotte County are co-hosting a 4-H Air Rifle and Air Pistol State Match Qualifier in accordance with the 2026 Kansas State 4-H Shooting Sports Spring match rulebook for the Air Rifle and Air Pistol disciplines. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from ages 9 to 18 years. *Note: only those who are 4-H age 9 (as of Jan. 1, 2026) and above are eligible to compete at the State match in Air Rifle and age 10 (as of Jan. 1, 2026) in the Air Pistol State Match.*

Registration forms are due by Saturday, Feb. 28, 2026. Late registrations will only be accepted to fill relays. Registrations will only be accepted from one person per county and this person will be notified of relay times. Registration begins at 8 am with the first relay beginning at 9 am. Names, birthdate, division and ages should be verified by the coach when checking in. **Fees are \$15 per discipline.** Fees will be collected at the match. Check payable to 4-H Air Rifle.

Air Rifle (Sunday only): Participants will shoot 60 shots in 3P (kneeling, prone, standing) with 20 shots per position. Rules will follow the current CMP National Standard 3P Air Rifle rulebook and the 2026 Kansas State Spring Match rules. We will be recognizing 1st year shooters in the Air Rifle discipline for both JR and SR divisions. Please make sure to mark on the registration form if your shooter is 1st year. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each category for positions and aggregate. Team awards will be determined by Orion scoring, choosing the top 4 shooters in each county.

A State Match Qualifying score: 450 points out of a possible 600.

Air Pistol (Sunday only): Participants will shoot 40 shots at 8 bulls with 5 shots per bull. FLAT NOSE pellets only. Rules will follow the current NRA-USAS Progressive Air Pistol rulebook and the 2026 Kansas State Spring Match rules. Juniors age 13 and under will shoot one or two handed unsupported. Seniors age 14 & up will shoot one handed unsupported. We will be recognizing 1st year shooters in the Air Pistol discipline for both JR and SR divisions. Please make sure to mark on the registration form if your shooter is 1st year. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 JR and SR shooters in aggregate. Team awards will be determined by Orion scoring, choosing the top 2 shooters in each county.

A State Match Qualifying score: 280 points out of a possible 400.

A concession stand will be available provided by Leavenworth and Wyandotte County families.
