Leavenworth County and Wyandotte County are co-hosting a 4-H BB Gun State Match Qualifier in accordance with the 2026 Kansas State 4-H Shooting Sports Spring match rulebook for the BB gun discipline. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from ages 8 to 18 years. If a participant turns 16 before the first shot of the match, they are ineligible to participate. *Note: only those who are 4-H age 9 (as of Jan. 1, 2026) and above are eligible to compete at the State match.*

Registration forms are due by Saturday, Feb. 28, 2026. Late registrations will only be accepted to fill relays. Registrations will only be accepted from one person per county and this person will be notified of relay times. Registration begins at 8 am with the first relay beginning at 9 am. Names, birthdate, division and ages should be verified by the coach when checking in. **Fees are \$15 per discipline.** Fees will be collected at the match. Check payable to 4-H Air Rifle.

BB Gun (Saturday only): Participants will shoot 10 bull shots in each of the 4 positions. Rules will follow the Daisy match, the NRA BB Gun rulebook and the 2026 Kansas State Spring Match rules. A "Fun Shoot" will be available for 8 years old. We will be recognizing 1st year shooters in the BB discipline for both JR and SR divisions, which will be determined by the registrations received. Please make sure to mark on the registration form if your shooter is 1st year. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each category for positions and aggregate. (Adjustments may be made to JR and SR age brackets if necessary). Team awards will be determined by Orion scoring, choosing the top 5 shooters in each county.

A State Match Qualifying score: 335 points out of a possible 400.

A concession stand will be available provided by Leavenworth and Wyandotte County families.
